## WHAT IS TalentNEO?

TalentNEO uses a skills-based hiring model to help employers consider the skill score of a prospective employee as a part of their hiring process.



The traditional way of hiring relies on degrees, resumes, and experience as the best predictors of a candidate's potential to succeed on the job. However, many companies are not finding candidates with the right skills. TalentNEO uses WorkKeys® as a validated reference for the candidate's current skill levels and their ability to effectively learn on the job since this is not always immediately apparent through education levels and experience. TalentNEO uses objective and validated measures of workplace skills for jobs across all levels -- from entry to executive.

# **HOW DOES TalentNEO MATCH JOBSEEKERS WITH EMPLOYERS?**

When employers post a job opening, OhioMeansJobs.com automatically assigns WorkKeys skills scores to the position description, indicating the skill levels preferred for that particular job. Job seekers take WorkKeys assessments and receive skills scores, which can then be used to conduct a job search based on a skills scores match. Job opportunities are available to jobseekers based on their scores. In Cuyahoga and Summit counties, more and more job seekers are taking WorkKeys assessments and can voluntarily include their results with their application or on their resumes.

## WHAT ARE WORKKEYS ASSESSMENTS?

#### WHICH SKILLS SCORES ARE UTILIZED?

Extensive research and data from nearly 20,000 occupations has identified three foundational skills essential to success in most jobs –

- Applied Mathematics: applying mathematical reasoning to work-related problems.
- Locating Information: using information taken from workplace graphics such as diagrams, floorplans, charts, and graphs.
- Reading for Information: reading and understanding work-related instructions and policies.

#### HOW ARE THE SKILLS SCORES ASSIGNED TO MY JOB POSTING?

Based on the job title, OhioMeansJobs.com uses technology that incorporates WorkKeys job profiles and publicly available O\*Net codes to determine the necessary Applied Mathematics, Locating Information, and Reading for Information skills scores associated with your specific position. Skills Scores are added automatically to your job description, and there is no cost.

#### WHAT DO THE SCORES ACTUALLY MEAN?
