The Fast-Track CNC Operations Certificate program prepares individuals for a career in the manufacturing industry. The program helps to meet the demand for Computer Numerical Controls (CNC) operators. Students have the opportunity to earn industry recognized credential upon completion. Graduates will be able to perform basic machine setup, including mounting and setting tools, conduct production runs, adjust offsets and complete records. The Right Skills Now program includes lecture, online, and hands-on instructional delivery.
